Approval of Minutes

Campus Safety

- As background, after the school-wide evacuation that took place on February 14th, parent & teacher combo, Annalyn Peluso and Farah Maisonneuve., developed a child a “Tagging System”. The Tagging System will help with the parent/emergency contact pick up process that takes place when there is an evacuation.
- Ms. Peluso and Farah demonstrated the “Tagging System” to Site Council.
- There will be a pilot of this system on May 29, 2019 with the third grade class.
