Noticed that College of Marin wasn't following the recommended environmental norms that most construction projects follow. Friends of Kentfield Kids and Creek's represents a group of Marin residents - almost 800 petition signers - who are concerned about the potential impacts from COM Maintenance and Operations Facility project. FKK&C Mission on this: Get the leadership of the COM to take action: 1) Stop the construction of the facility, 2) Conduct an independent EIR (Environmental Impact Report) of the project and 3) Commit to mitigate any impacts.

COM has blamed poor communication for the discontent and promised to do better. But FKK&C believes this is a much bigger issue. Issues include: No community input of consent. COM was given bad advice and made a bad choice by hiring an outside company.
